INVITATION

Dear colleagues,

We are very pleased to invite you on 24 January 2008 to the first Swiss interdisciplinary conference on *Pain management in Neonates: Investing in the Future*.

The Institute of Nursing Science of the University of Basel, Switzerland is organizing this conference in close collaboration with the Inselspital Bern and with the invaluable support of the Swiss Society of Neonatology and the Swiss Society for the Study of Pain.

Until the mid-80s, it was denied that neonates experienced pain. The treatment of neonatal pain was accordingly deficient. Nowadays, however, there is evidence that early and repeated pain exposure can compromise infant's development. The assessment, prevention and treatment of pain therefore remain central issues in neonatal care and challenge the entire interdisciplinary neonatal care team, i.e. nurses, neonatologists, pediatricians, midwives as well as obstetricians.

This conference is dedicated to these challenges: the latest evidence from research and clinical practice on (preterm) neonatal pain will be showcased; the neurophysiologic particularities of the developing brain of preterm infants and the possible consequences of early pain experience will be presented. In addition, central aspects of pain assessment and treatment, the difficulties in implementing evidence in clinical practice as well as the elaboration of today's off-label medication and the expected changes in legislation will be discussed.

The conference will be closed with an experts' panel discussion where future directions in research concerning pain management in neonates will be debated upon.


We are looking forward to an exciting conference with stimulating discussions and hope to welcome you on 24 January 2008 personally in the Auditorium Ettore Rossi of the Inselspital Bern.
